Giles Trendle, Managing Director of Al Jazeera English, talks of the media and the Middle East. Combining anecdotes and analysis, Giles describes the increasing challenges faced by journalists working in a region widely regarded as the most difficult and dangerous in which to operate.



Giles Trendle is the Managing Director of Al Jazeera English Channel where he oversees an editorial staff of over 400 people based in its centres of Doha, London, Washington DC and Kuala Lumpur, as well as in over 70 bureaux around the world. Giles first joined Al Jazeera in 2004 to work on the Arabic channel's flagship investigative documentary show before moving to Al Jazeera English ahead of its launch in 2006. He began his career in the mid 1980's as a freelance print journalist based in Lebanon covering that country's civil war. He has also worked in Iraq, Egypt, Israel and the Palestinian territories, Jordan, Saudi Arabia and Afghanistan.
